Kindergarten open to public

Oakland University's Lowry Early Childhood Center offers two programs designed for children of kindergarten age. The program for "Young 5s" is a half-day, five days a week class coordinated to meet the needs of children who are not ready for the traditional kindergarten classroom. The program runs on the university calendar and tuition is \$110 per month.

The kindergarten program is a full day class from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (with before and after school care an option). Children who are "strong 5s" developmentally or children who need a year between kindergarten and first grade are encouraged to enroll. Tuition for the full day program is \$245 per month.
