Smaller living spaces, particularly in urban areas, prohibit garden plots. And the frequent moves of modern life tend to discourage putting down roots, even for plants.

So it's easy to understand why container gardening has become increasingly popular in our mobile society. All a light and access for watering and fertilizing the plants.

and one-square-foot outlet for each 300 square feet of ceiling area.

Second is the use of vapor barriers in the attic between the inside air and the insulation. Insulation in batts and blankets can be bought with a vapor barrier already attached to one side.

New homes or those without attic insulation should be fitted with this type of fiber-glass insulation with the vapor barrier (facing) side installed towards the warm-in-winter (heated) part of the home. Attics with some existing insula-tion require unfaced fiber-glass insula-

tion with no vapor barrier.
