"The whole idea is to have it done this year," Biasell said. "The roads will be open during the entire project." Farmington Hills City Council Monday adopted a road paving special assessment of approximately \$217,537 for the 126 households in the neighborhood south of Collars, between Farmington and Gill roads.

That means that each household would receive an assessment of about \$1,688 with the largest home in the area receiving an assessment of approximately \$2,026.


