Her artistry was highly acceptable and very sound.

parts. Costuming for the troupe was a variation of German-styled "Bavarian" peasant dresses and traditional white ballet dresses for the swan dances, accuried with the allegorical meaning of black and white as symbols of good and evil. Backdrops were simple but lovely — painted blue-green pleures of the forest and the ballroom of the castle.
