

# Ex-Falcon flyer guns for MAC title

In 1976, Craig Kieley was an impressive long jumper. One guy that impressed him a lot was Bruce Jenner.

It was in '78 that Jenner raced, vaulted, vaulted, hustled and added his way to a gold medal in the decathlon at the Montreal Olympics. Kieley always remembered the decathlon. To him it "looked interesting." It was something he might like to try.

"That dream reached reality. Kieley, now a sophomore at Central Michigan, is a favorite to win the Mid-American Conference (MAC) decathlon title May 17 at Kent State. And should he manage to score about 250 points higher than his best effort thus far, he'll off to the NCAA meet May 30.

"WINNING THE MAC TITLE is one goal for Kieley, who graduated from Farmington. But it isn't the most immediate.

## Orsini fires 3-hitter to snap Harrison out of doldrums

A Western Lakes conference victory had eluded Farmington Harrison for the first four weeks of the season.

But, thanks to the superb three-hit pitching of Steve Orsini and some timely hitting by D.J. Murry, the Hawks broke out of their slide by whipping Northville 7-3 Monday.

Orsini, 2-0 on the season, walked six and struck out five. After giving up two runs in the first inning, Orsini really shut the door on the Mustangs the rest of the way.

Harrison scored four times in their half of the first, the big blow being Murry's three-run home run. Murry also ripped a double in the game.

"We've been real inconsistent," said Harrison coach John Herrington. "We

"have two more years to win the MAC," he said. "Right now, the biggest goal I have is to qualify for the NCAA."

"My goal at the beginning of the year was to get a gold medal in the decathlon at the Olympic Trials. Kieley might be concentrating on the NCAA meet and the Olympic trials if not for a series of costly injuries."

After a successful first season in the decathlon — as a CMU freshman he qualified for the Junior Nationals, finishing 11th in only his third decathlon competition — he dislocated his shoulder last year while pole vaulting and missed the entire season.

He WAS REDSHIRTED, thus saving his eligibility, but this year started off where he left off. Kieley twisted his left ankle in the team's indoor intramural meet last November, then jammed his right ankle in CMU's first indoor meet against Ferris State a month later.

played a real poor game against Bechtel last week and then a bad first inning against Canton on Friday. But, we're starting to get a lot better up the middle. Brian Smolinski (sophomore shortstop) is starting to make some key plays for us. Hopefully, we'll be all-right."

Pitcher Bob Waszczenko took the mound against his former teammates Friday — Plymouth Canton — and the Chiefs greeted him with six first-inning runs en route to an 11-7 win.

The Hawks are now 3-3 in the season, 1-4 in the league. They face a grueling seven-games-in-five-days schedule the rest of this week.

That, of course, is what separates athletes from athletes — their ability to turn in strong performances in event after event. Kieley is adapting well to

it, but it takes time.

"I'm still learning how to do 200 m in the morning," he said. "I'm not racing alone yet, but I'm getting a lot of room for improvement, but I'm getting a full amount of points."

WITH THE MAC MEET a week away, Kieley is no longer trying to build up for the strength and endurance events.

"It's too late to increase strength, so the only thing I can really do is get my speed up. I'm getting my quickness back, but I haven't worked on that too much. I've got to improve my hurdles."

Should Kieley miss the NCAA qualifying meet — his current best is 7,194 points, the NCAA standard is 7,450 — at the MAC meet, he'll get one more shot May 18-19 at the Central Collegiate Conference championships at Northwestern University.

That's something he wants to avoid. It's possible.
