Course" includes a glossary of definitions, plus lists of measurements, important scientific equivalents and aids. The listings are so useful that she frequently refers to them when dealing with other cook books.

Began in the spring of 1983, Swanson finally completed the book in time for publication in fall, 1983. She used a humorous writing style that pokes fun at college texts because it was addressed to a college student.

"COOK 101 is a cook book designed for undergraduate and graduate students living away from home, thrust into the reality of living quarters and nourishing themselves on a daily basis," she wrote.

THE EFFORT that went into creating the manuscript, she said, made her appreciate cook books in general.

"You have to be absolutely sure that you are accurate. Often times you find that when you were one of the book, but there are still some errors. However, the recipes are all accurate."

Unsure whether the first effort will lead to a second, Swanson says that she is concentrating her attention on a new job at Dimitri's Wildflower, a West Bloomfield eatery at Drake and Walnut

"One of my favorite parts of cooking is the creativity," said Swanson.
