Museum celebrates 100th anniversary

The Detroit Institute of Arts began a special year-long celebration to honor its 100th anniversary last month.
The centennial program, titled "The Celebration of Excellence," encompasses all areas of the museum, and includes major exhibitions, performing arts presentations, art commissions and one-time events, special educational programs and publications.
Among the highlights will be an exhibition exploring automotive design and its impact on

American art, a major international loan exhibition devoted to Italian Renaissance sculpture, an exhibition of works by contemporary artist Bruce Nauman, and a collection of the works of Mexican artist Diego Rivera and French painter Francois Boucher.
During the centennial, the Detroit Institute of Art (DIA) will also highlight its own collection, one of the finest and most comprehensive in the U.S., and four special exhibitions based on its holdings throughout Michigan.

Joseph L. Hudson Jr., president of the Arts Commission of the City of Detroit which supervises the museum, said, "The year-long centennial program provides the Detroit Institute of Arts with the opportunity to celebrate the achievements of the past 100 years and build excitement and momentum for the next 100."
Frederick Cummings, director of the DIA, said, "For the centennial we have organized an outstanding series of exhibitions and spe-

cial projects that provide us with the opportunity to showcase all areas of our activity. We are extremely pleased that most of the exhibitions will be nationally and internationally and have, as well, set up many statewide projects, so we will be able to share our celebration with the entire state."
The premiere centennial exhibition, "Automobile and Culture - Detroit Style," will open in June 1985.
