Eastwood, 54, co-starred with a talking mule in his first picture, "Francis in the Navy" (1955), which predates the TV series "Rawhide," for which he won some small fame. But the Italian-made "Pistful of Dollars" — shot in 1964, released in 1966 — really introduced the laconic star and spaghetti westerns to American film audiences.

Conductor keeps good control in 'King David'

It seemed like a celebration of spring as far as concerts are concerned. Among the many musical events proliferating on that May Sunday is the sed dom heard work of Honegeer, 'King David,' that was held at the Fort Street Presbyterian Church in Detroit.

The tradition of performing music in piaces of worship dates back to biblical times with some instances mentioned in the story of David. Thus, this performance in a sense had an authentic Havor.

HONEGGER'S work, in three parts, describes King David's life from the time of his annointment to the time of his death. The story, told by a narrator, is reinforced by the musical entries of the chorusand solosits with orthestral accompaniment.

A major characteristic of Honegger's music in his case is the fact that the background sounds seem appropriate to the narration. The orchestra parts, in particular create this feeling throughout. Conductor, David Daniels, maintained excellent control throughout the performance, creating a feeling of unison between all different factions. However, some of the choruses, especially in the third part, were overpowered by the orchestra. The soloitst included David Bryant, boy treble; Edward Kingins, tenor, Elsie Easelman, mezzo soprano, and imogene Bird, soprano.

Bryant sang the opening aris of David the shepherd. He wore the uniform of an altar boy and made a very nice impression overall although one could tell from his higher notes that his career in this register will be short lived.

Kingins, tenor, fit well into the role of this music. In the first part, his voice created a suitable impression to the story being told.


