INSTRUCTIONAL SPORTS CAMP — Instructional Sports Camp will be offered this summer by Farmington Hills Parks & Recreation and Oakland Community College. The camps will be during the summer at Orchard Ridge Campus in Farmington Hills. The purpose of the Instructional Sports Camps will be to provide a personal approach to the development of skills and techniques particular to each sport.

Camp enrollment will be geared to a small student-instructor ratio and will be available for both boys and girls of middle-school age and above. Each individual will receive instruction in a natural progression suited to his/her needs. Attention will be paid to all aspects of each activity. The camp will include basketball, baseball, fast-pitch softball, golf, tennis, wrestling, cheerleading, fitness/conditioning, cross country, volleyball, soccer and diving. GOLF LESSONS — Learn the basic fundamentals or improve your established skills through structured lessons at Silger Golf Range. Classes are 50 minutes in length, twice each week for four weeks and will begin June 18 for children, teens and adults. Each participant will be asked to buy a bucket of balls for each lesson. Registrations should be made at the Parks & Recreation office, 418 for children/teens and adults and \$10 for senior adults.

SAFETY TOWN — Safety Town is an educational setting by which safety lessons are taught with the child learning through actual participation and demonstrations. Instructions include pedestrian, motorist, bus, stranger, po-

lice, fire, railroad crossings, bicycle, drug and general play and home safety. Farmington Hills Safety Town is for children entering kindergarten this fall. All other 4-, 5- and 6-year-olds will also be accepted. Sessions will begin in late June and continue through mid-August. The fee is \$30 per child with registrations being accepted. Register early, space is limited.

Spartan camps focus on learning

Michigan State University launches its fourth season of "Spartan Ventures" for young learners June 17 on the East Lansing campus.

The one-week enrichment sessions are sponsored by MSU Lifelong Education Programs. Separate camps focus on biology, the physical sciences, math and writing and computer literacy.

"The need to interest youngsters in math and science has been a matter for national debate for the past year," notes Dr. Julian Brandow, Ventures coordinator and assistant dean of the College of Natural Science.

Age requirements vary by camp, and enrollment must be made at least two weeks before starting date. For information, contact Spartan Ventures, 47 Kellogg Center, MSU, East Lansing 48824-1022; call (517) 355-4541.

The June 17 to Aug. 10 program combines classroom sessions with field trips and recreational activities. The camps are supervised by faculty and MSU resident advisors.

New to the lineup this year is "Pencils and Problems," which stresses expository writing and math skills. Open to youngsters ages 12 to 15, the sessions are June 17-22 and June 24-29.

Other sessions include:

- Computer Camp, June 24-29, July 8-13, and July 22-27, and Aug. 5-10.
- Physical Science Sampler, June 17-22 and July 15-20.
- Biological Science Sampler, June 24-29 and Aug. 5-10.

- Michigan Chess Association Junior Chess Camp, June 21-29, with international chess master Arthur Bisguier, an editor of "Chess Life."
