nies Vista, Michigan, Wayne, Wolverino and Wolverino Disposal-Detroit, and several induvieulos associated with those tirms. The suit seeks damages under the Sher-man Anti-Trust Act and the Racketeer in-fluenced Corrupt Organizations (RICO) Act.

CWW SECRETARY Maurice Breen, Plymouth Township, Supervisor, said the group has requested action through Licas' office because the communities actaily contract with the county for wastewater disposal. The county for turn, holds the con-tracts with Detroit.

As of Tuesday, Lucas had not decided if he would intervene on behalf of the com-munities, according to Bill Johnson, Lucas'

press spokesman.

The county executive is waiting for the written CWW resolution, but talked with Livonla Mayor Edward McNamara — head of the group — about the request earlier this week, Johnson said.

"He (Lucas) will give it some thought and determine if he should get involved," Johnsbn said.

Young was unavailable for comment on the suit Tuesday.

Although a dollar amount-hasn't been given in regard to the total alleged dam-ages, McNamara speculated the disposal cost could have been inflated as much as 50 cents per ton of sludge.
