Butler holds four degrees from the University of Michigan including a doctorate in electrical engineering. He is author of two books and more than 30 publications.

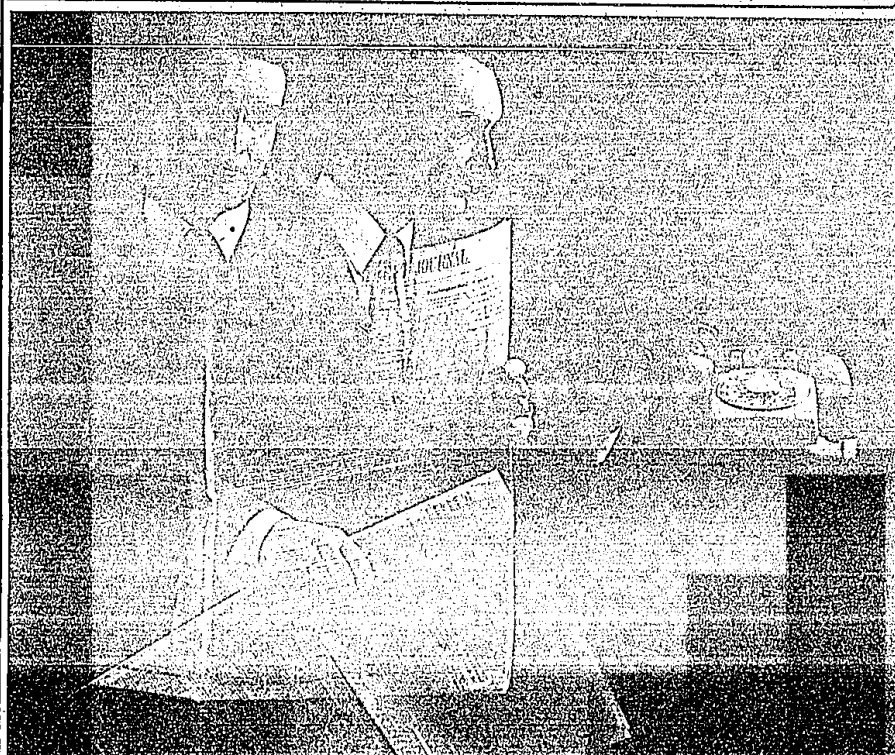
