

Furies set sights on national crown

"George Pacheco is a bit of a soft touch as a father. When his three daughters asked him if he would coach their soccer team, he agreed."

That was in 1976. This year, the team enters its ninth season with four members from that original squad still playing on what has become a local powerhouse.

"I started it because of my daughters," said Pacheco, whose three daughters — Julie, Suzie and Debbie — remain as team members. "They wanted to play."

But Pacheco never dreamed the team he started in 1975 would be in ex-

istence today. Neither did he believe they would experience such success.

"I expected the girls to be very good because they were all good athletes," Pacheco said. "But, no, I never thought they would do all that they have done."

WHAT THE TEAM — known as the Farmington Furies — has done is to reach the Region II finals of the Women's Amateur Cup National Tournament in the semifinals June 23, with the title match slated for the following day.

"We have a better team than we did last year," said Pacheco. "This year we're a much more balanced team, we're a stronger team overall."

and Illinois will battle for the Region II championship June 9 in Minneapolis. The winner advances to the national finals June 23-24 in St. Louis. The Region II champ meets the Region III victor in the semifinals June 23, with the title match slated for the following day.

GNAU HAS MADE a major contribution to the Furies. The former Bloomfield Hills Laker proved her worth in the game that got the Furies to the regional semifinals. In a 5-0 blanking of Ohio North, Gnaus scored three goals. Debbie and Suzie Pacheco added single scores, and Debbie adding three assists.

This is not a typical all-star team, with statewide talent burgeoning the

area. Team members come from Farmington Hills (the Pachecos), West Bloomfield (Gnaus), Birmingham (Pacheco), and Oak Ridge (Gnaus) and Livonia (Julie Chas). All but four of the 18 Furies played for Michigan State.

Now 24, Pacheco has a string of the sport. She remains the Furies' top scorer. Her sister, Suzie, plays in the midfield.

The Furies play in the Great Lakes Women's Soccer League. Last year they finished second, with a 16-1 record to the FLWP Rowdies, a younger team that has had great success both locally and in tournaments.

"BEYOND THE ROWDIES, I don't think there is a more talented team in the area (than the Furies)," said Pacheco.

But find out just how strong his squad is at the Region II finals. The tournament will be played by intercollegiate rules, which allow just two substitutions during the game.

"We're going to have to have a lot of endurance," said Pacheco. "We'll be playing two 45-minute halves with, really, only one substitution. We'll have to save one in case of an injury." It's a challenge, but that won't be anything new for the Furies. In nine years they've faced loads of difficult challenges, and come out on top in most.

Russians stay home, but AAU game is on

The Russians aren't coming, but the International Basketball Classic will go on as scheduled Tuesday at Livonia's Schoolcraft College. And officials of the tournament still expect to see some pretty good basketball.

The Russians, who canceled their U.S. tour to go along with the Olympic boycott, have been replaced by a line contingent of cage stars from Canada.

Michigan's Mr. Basketball, Demetrius Gore, will head a solid cast of Michigan stars that will battle the Ontario Provincial men's team in the main event at 8 p.m.

"Quite naturally, it won't be as prestigious a tournament as playing the Soviet Union in an Olympic arena," said Rocky Watkins, Michigan AAU coach. "But the Canadians have a fairly good team and we expect some good competition."

THE CANADIAN team will be led by

Mario Tarnatino, winner of the Rogin Award, Canada's version of Michigan's Mr. Basketball.

The Michigan AAU squad is made up of three teams — Detroit, Metro and Michigan, with Michigan being the top club. The players were selected from the ranks of 253 cagers that tried out.

"I think we have well-balanced teams, but more so than in recent years," Watkins said. "We don't have as many big name players, but they play well together."

The Michigan team, featuring the most talented players in the state, lost to Anderson, Ind., last month in the Midwest Zone Regional, losing an automatic berth in the AAU Junior Nationals. But Watkins is still optimistic the team will get one of three at-large bids for the July tournament in Jacksonville, Fla. He hopes to use the Classic to showcase the team.

"It was the first time we've ever lost a zone tournament," Watkins said of Michigan's 140-129 loss to Anderson.

"Our team played well, but we didn't get any breaks."

ANDERSON WENT to the foul line 60 times (converting 44) in the game, while Michigan was given just 36 opportunities (making 17).

"We actually scored 16 more points in field goals than they," Watkins said. "The officiating obviously hurt us."

Watkins said Michigan, which has two national junior titles under its belt, merits an "excellent chance" of getting an at-large bid because of its performance this season and in the past. Michigan's "super five" starters include Eli Parker (Purdue Central), Jeff Grayer (Purdue Northwest), Tony Hoff (Oak Park), Gary Thompson (Jackson) and Gore (Detroit Chassey). They will be joined by Archie Tullis

(Saginaw Buena Vista) and Clarence Jones (Detroit Southwestern), who missed the Anderson trip.

Catholic Central junior John McIntyre and Livonia Stevenson's Tom Donato, who will be attending Montana State this fall, give the team solid bench support.

WHILE WATKINS said his Michigan squad is tentatively set, members of the other two teams still have a shot at making the No. 1 team.

"With a great effort, a player can bump a member of our top team," he said. "Carlos Briggs (Schoolcraft) is a good example. He played so well, we just couldn't keep him off it."

Local stars trying to do just that include Phil Graczyk (Livonia Bentley) and Eric Hartnett (Plymouth Salem).

The tournament will kick off at 4 p.m. with a preliminary matchup between Michigan's under-17 state champions, led by Birmingham Brother Rice junior guard B.J. Armstrong and 6-foot-10 J.P. Oosterbaan of Kalamazoo Christian against a very strong Buffalo, N.Y., AAU team.

The Detroit and Metro teams will tip-off at 6, followed by the main event at 8.
