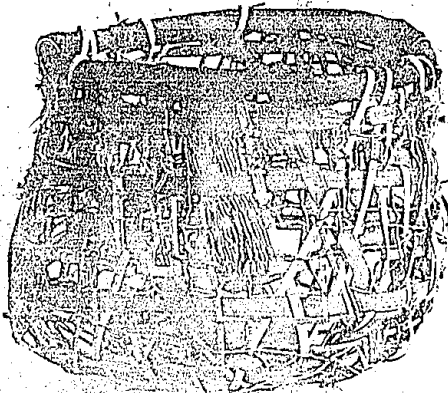


Innovating with baskets
