

File for House seat as planned

Prospective candidates for the state House of Representatives are being urged to file for office as planned despite last week's court ruling that legislative districts were drawn up unconstitutionally.

With the filing deadline at 4 p.m. Tuesday, both Democratic and Republican county officials said they believe most of their nominees are secure. But they won't be certain until the Michigan Supreme Court reviews last week's ruling by Oakland County Circuit Judge George LaPlata.

"The whole thing is a little nebulous," said Ray Penner, executive director of the Oakland County Democratic Party. "We have absolutely no idea what will happen, so we're encouraging candidates to continue to file."

Republican political director Paul Welsky is also "waiting to see how this plays out." "We're gonna go ahead and file, and if the Michigan Supreme Court upholds the decision we'll review things."

LAPLATA'S DECISION came on a challenge to reapportionment from five Oakland County residents. The Michigan Supreme Court immediately planned a review.

Until the high court rules, the Oakland County clerk's office is accepting nominating petitions for the Aug. 7 partisan primaries on the basis of districts drawn up by the Michigan Legislature last December.

Generally, Republicans have been unhappy with the new reapportionment plan because districts slice across city and township boundaries more frequently than under an earlier plan.

Spreen will try to oust Murphy

Oakland County executive Daniel Murphy, a Republican, and Oakland County sheriff Johannes Spreen, a Democrat, have been battling for years.

The battle may get even fiercer, however, Spreen has decided to challenge Murphy for his job.

Spreen, 64, announced Friday that he won't seek a fourth term as sheriff but will run for county executive.

To face incumbent Murphy in the November general election, Spreen will have to win the Democratic nomination in the August primary.

That may be easy, Spreen has proven vote-getting ability being elected sheriff as a Democrat in a Republican county. The only other announced candidate for the Democratic nomination is Capt. Billy J. Nolin of sheriff's department.

A Farmington resident, Spreen has been in law enforcement for 44 years, including several years as chief of police in Detroit. He holds a master's degree in public administration.

"I understand how county government should work, and I have seen how it really works," Spreen said in a press conference announcing his candidacy.

The sheriff attacked the direction Oakland County has been taking. The county government, he said, has become "more and more narrow in its focus and more and more partisan in its actions."

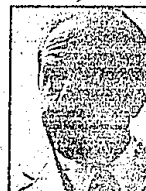
Spreen said, "No one group of people in Oakland County is entitled to control government for all the people. Government should exist to serve all of the people of this county, not just those who belong to a select group."

Despite a history of confrontations with the Republican majority on the county board of commissioners, Spreen said partisan politics will not be a

problem if he becomes executive.

"I think we will get along very well. I'd be operating from a different vantage point."

Asked to comment on rumors that Gov. James Blanchard offered him a job if he failed to become executive, Spreen said he met with Blanchard but "he did not offer me anything, and I did not ask for anything."

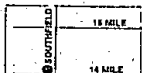

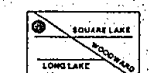
