Memories, memories... have we got the memories, and we'd like to share them with you. Using local newspaper files, we're dishing up generous slices of life in the Farmington community from 40, 30, 20 and 10 years ago.

JUNE 8, 1944 —
"TUESDAY, JUNE 6, is one day that no American will ever forget," noted around the Block item on the front page of the Farmington Enterprise. "Farmington paused, along with the rest of the nation, for a brief period of prayer and silence. As the sirens blew and the church bells rang, all traffic and pedestrians halted, and as the organ music played and the strains of 'The Old Rugged Cross' were heard, every head was bowed. Our thoughts and our prayers are with our boys over there, and we wish them God-Speed and a quick return home."

THE BLOOD BANK unit of the Red Cross netted 211 pints of whole blood, 11 pints over a set quota, while collecting in Farmington on June 5. Dr. Z.H. Aschen Brenner, chairman of the blood bank unit, and Mrs. Howard Warner, chairman in charge of the arrangements here, expressed thanks for the fine response.

A NEW ATTRACTION — THE "World's Fair Freak Show" — was advertised at Edgewater Park at Grand River and Seven Mile Road in Detroit. All rides except for the roller coaster cost 10 cents.

RATES FOR ENTERPRISE classified ads were 1 1/2 cents a word with a

minimum of 35 cents. Display ads in the classified section cost 50 cents per inch.

CLASSIFIED AD: "FOR SALE — Thoroughbred Duroc sow and 8 pigs. Lyman Bush, 29250 Halsted."

JUNE 10, 1954 — KEN KEMP was elected president of the Farmington Lions Club for the coming year. Other elected officers were Edward Stach, first vice president; Dr. Herbert Viergut, second vice president; Benjamin Bonner, third vice president; Ken Lachman, secretary; and John Jendritz, treasurer.

THE STARS AND STRIPES were raised over the Farmington Little League baseball diamond in city park to signify the official opening of the 1954 season. Members of the Farmington High School band, city officials and Little League players and managers participated in the ceremony.

AN EDITORIAL said: "The 'Yes' and 'No' policy of the Soviet Union is about to be tested again. Last week they voted against a proposal to submit the Indo-China conflict to the United Nations Security Council."

"Since they were the lone dissenter, the question is to be included on the Council agenda. Russia seems to have the confusing habit of voting 'Yes' for anything it tries to do. However, there is probably a motive behind the confusion. The Reds want to be in on the act, but they don't want the embarrassing experience of tumbling off the high wire."

ATTRACTIONS AT Farmington's Civic Theatre included "The Naked Jungle" with Charlton Heston and Eleanor Parker, and "Rob Roy" with Richard Todd and Glynis Johns.

SHORT ITEM: "Women just wouldn't get everything said if they spoke one at a time."

JUNE 11, 1964 — THE KEITH JOHNSON Award, the highest honor which could be given to a graduating senior at Farmington High School, was presented to Carol Lawabe by Assistant Principal Clayton Graham at a recent ceremony. The award was established by the FHS Class of 1941 in memory of classmate Keith Johnson, who was stricken with a fatal illness during his senior year.

Summing up, Prutow touted her experience on the board as her leading qualification.
