

THAT'S WHY lots of residents attending the Farmington Founders Festival will spend a few cents at the Jaycee Dunking Booth. The booth features a Farmington Jaycee sitting on a chair strategically perched above a large tank of cold water.

A rope connects the chair and a target which, when hit by a tossed ball, triggers a spring releasing the Jaycee for a cool dip.

The booth will be located on the Himmelspach parking lot three days of the Festival, starting at noon, Thursday til

10 p.m., all day Friday, and after the parade Saturday until 10 p.m.

A shift of some 30-40 Jaycees will man the booth during the Festival with members sitting for two hours at a time.

THE MONEY YOU spend for a good laugh will be used for the many good community causes sponsored by the Jaycees.

Besides the dunking booth, the Jaycees will be operating games throughout the downtown center area during the Festival.

The popular ring toss will be back and the old starby - throwing balls at Coke bottles. Another game will be tossing balls through an old tire with three balls through the target winning a prize.

Good Junk Being Sold

Antiques and glorious junk will be on sale during all three days of the Farmington Founders Festival, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day, at the Farmington Community Center on Farmington Rd. just north of 10 Mile Rd.

A number of Farmington families have dug into their cellars to donate choice treasures. Attics have been emptied to provide just plain junk because one man's trash is another man's treasure.

Items going on sale range from antimacassars to xylophones.

Another Center contribution to the Festival will be a second Max Davey concert to wind up events on Sunday, July 26, at 4 p.m. on the Center grounds.

Davey, his singers and orchestra, will present a concert entitled "America, Yesterday and Today." Admission is free.

Also, on Thursday night, July 23, Davey and his singers will present a musical program on the Chrysler Show Boat in the Downtown Center.

Davey's presentation downtown will start immediately after the concert by the Franklin Village Band.


