


Freedom festival offers films

Jacques Couvreur's Great Lakes chronicle, "St. Lawrence: Stairway to the Sea," will have its Detroit premiere at 8 p.m. Saturday, June 23, as part of Cinema Canada. The 23th Inter-



national Freedom Festival opens Friday, June 22, and continues through Wednesday, July 4. More than 50 events, mostly free, will be held throughout downtown Detroit, Windsor and surrounding communities. Rock, country, jazz, R&B, gospel and other kinds of music will be presented daily during the festival, on the Mainstage at Detroit's Hart Plaza.


