"No matter what, they say 'Get me one of those.' But I can't," she said.
"They're all out."

"It's very selective," said Bill John-son, press secretary for Wayne County Executive Bill Lucas, whose signature is etched across a gold pin.

"Those of us on staff have a hard time getting them ourselves."

Oakisad County Commissioner-James Doyon, D. Madison Heights, was olfered \$150 for the Hart pin he wears every day. He commonly mittaken for a Gary Hart for president pin. 
