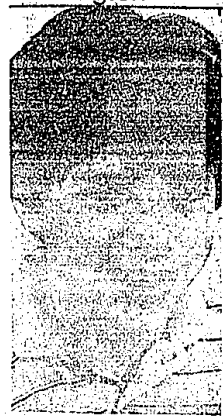


carrier of the month Farmington
