Born in Lebanou among the three percent Armenian population "which was small, but very influential," Tarian grew up speaking Armenian, Arabic, English, French and Turkish lan-

It was not until his older brother,

Wayne, Ind., had come to the United
States that Tarian's adventures in
Western culture "and my discovery
that art was to be my lifework" began.
"A youngster who was poor didn't
even dream of such a career," he recalled, standing in his Bloomfield
Township atudio, amidst dozens of
works "in transition."

MUCH OF his work is dreamlike. The somber faces, line-featured, beautiful in almost idealized contours, gaze into the distance, their haunting expressions reflections of the aftermath of the 1915 invasion of the Turks.
