Buying art

Custom framing, with choice of frame and mat and the art dry mounted, can be expensive. With an unusually large piece the framing cost can be very high.

An alternative is gallery mounting. Both galler-tes offer this technique, which is an acid free plas-fic wrapped around a half-inch thick board edged with a border tape. This keeps the cost way down. A sl-inch by 35-inch poster will run around \$50 for gallery mounting. For a larger poster the savings are errater.
