"Lilles come in every color except blue, and there are many striking hi-colored and tri-colored varieties. Some

of the newest have "brushmarks" making them look as though touched with a paint brush. "Eminence," "Picasso" and "Adobe Fire are examples of these. Others have contrasting spots on the petials or are pure hue or white.

The Greeks grew lillies both for their orimental and medicinal value.

Since the Middle Ages, the lily has been the attribute of many saints, but particularly the Virgin Mary. No other plant has been more consistently used in works of art, painting, sculpture and verse than the lily.

Leonardo da Vincil drew a detailed, pencil aketch of the Madonna lily, a flower stalk identical with the ones still grown today.
