

## recreation news

Each week the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Department will present a synopsis of upcoming activities in this column. For further information regarding our programs, contact our office at 474-0115.

**INSTRUCTIONAL SPORTS CAMP** — Instructional Sports Camp will be offered this summer by parks and recreation and Oakland Community College. The camps will be held at the Orchard Ridge Campus in Farmington Hills. The purpose of the Instructional Sports Camps will be to provide a personal approach to the development of skills and techniques particular to each sport. Camp enrollment will be geared to a small student to instructor ratio, and will be available for both boys and girls of middle school age and above. Each individual will receive instruction in a natural progression suited to their needs. Attention will be paid to all aspects of each activity.

**DAY CAMPS** — Our day camp is designed for children 6-12 years old and provides both educational and recreational programs. Campers will be involved in animal study, insects, fishing, archery, field trips and more. Camp runs five days a week and the second session begins July 9. Registration fee is \$30.

**SUMMER FUN CENTERS** — We have opened six community playground sites that will run Monday, June 25, through Thursday, August 2. Supervised activities will include a variety of games, sports activities, arts and crafts and special events. All activities will include boys and girls, 6-13 years old (children must have completed first grade). The morning sites will be Kenbrook, Larkshire and Longacre Elementary schools from 9:30 a.m. to noon. The afternoon sites will be Flanders, William Grace and Wooddale Elementary schools, 1-3 p.m. There is no fee for this activity.

**JUNIOR GOLF LEAGUE** — A Junior Golf League has been structured for boys and girls ages 12-16 to participate in a five match league schedule with guidelines that will allow each member to compete with each league participant. League play will be held on Mondays and Fridays, beginning Friday, July 13. League members will also be eligible to participate in the Northwest Parks and Recreation golf tournament. Players will be arranged by the following age divisions: boys 12-14 and 15-16, girls 12-14 and 15-16. A first come-first serve registration will be held with a deadline of Friday, July 6. Registration fee is \$18 and includes all green fees.

**RECREATION OPEN SWIM** — Individuals can enjoy recreational swimming Monday through Thursday at Farmington and North Farmington High Schools. Swimming will be available 1-4 p.m. through Aug. 2. The fee is \$1 per person. Open swimming requires that all children be accompanied by an adult if the child's chin height is below 39 inches.

**KID'S DAY** — The 5th Annual Kid's Day celebration will again take place this summer at Farmington's City Park Tuesday, July 17. Activities will begin at 12 noon and continue to 8 p.m. Activities will include clowns, break dance and rotten sneaker contests, petting zoo, games, junior golf prize, sportsmobile and more.

**TENNIS TOURNAMENT** — Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation in cooperation with Oakland Community College, Orchard Ridge campus, is sponsoring the ninth annual Farmington Founder's Festival tennis tournament. This tournament is open to all those who qualify for amateur standing. Divisions will be held for men, women, teens, children, singles, doubles and mixed doubles. Play will begin Wednesday, July 18, and continue through until the Sunday, July 22. Registrations will be accepted prior to July 9 at the parks and recreation office.

## Scholarships given by Masonry group

The Masonry Institute of Michigan has awarded \$550 scholarships to three students in the School of Architecture at Lawrence Institute of Technology (LIT), Southfield.

The winners are: Sara Ellen Haselwardt, Chelsea; Paul Allen Lewis, Oak Park; and Wayne Evan Visbeen, Wixom.

Haselwardt and Lewis will begin their senior year at LIT in September. Visbeen will be entering the school's fifth-year program leading to a professional degree in architecture.

Two of the scholarships are named in honor of longtime Detroit area mason contractors — James R. Snyder and Robert F. Ebeling — in recognition of their years of service to the masonry industry. Snyder is president of J.R. Snyder Co., Inc. Wixom and Ebeling is chairman of Ebeling & Hicks, Inc. Romeo.

Visbeen received the eighth annual Snyder Scholarship. . . Lewis the seventh annual Ebeling Scholarship. . . Haselwardt the sixth annual Masonry Institute of Michigan Scholarship. All are of equal value and were awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement and professionally related activities.

Visbeen who earlier won the 1984 student masonry design competition sponsored by MIM and LIT has a family background in the masonry industry. His father studied architecture, became a bricklayer and now has a general contracting business in New Jersey where Wayne has spent several summers working as a bricklayer. Lewis became interested in architecture while working part time for the Bergman-Lorin Company — architects and contractors in Saginaw. Lewis is spending this summer with Yamasaki

& Associates as an architectural draftsman.

Haselwardt, who spent two years in the College of Civil Engineering at MSU, transferred to the school of architecture at LIT when she discovered she would rather build buildings than bridges. She will work as a draftsman for the Engineering Services Department at the University of Michigan this summer.
