

VA Sets \$14-Million In Improvements

The Veterans Administration has embarked on a new \$14 million construction and improvement program that involves 20 of its 166 hospitals, VA Administrator Donald E. Johnson disclosed Monday.

The largest project for which a contract was recently signed calls for air conditioning and modernization of the Waco, Tex. hospital. This will cost nearly \$8 million, the administrator said.

Other air conditioning projects include hospitals in West Roxbury, Mass., Muskogee, Okla., and the surgical suite at Buffalo, N.Y.

SMALLER projects involve the construction of 127 intensive care units for surgical, medical and coronary patients in 11 hospitals. Another 50 beds will be for pulmonary emphysema patients at hospitals in Temple, Tex., Fayetteville, Ark.

A contract also has been signed for the re-construction of the special activities building at the VA Center in Gulfport, Miss., which was heavily damaged by Hurricane Camille last year. This will cost \$1,025,000, Johnson stated.

Projects also include a nine-bed hemodialysis unit at Little Rock, Ark., and the replacement of the main heating plant at Hampton, Va.

Fair Entry Deadline Extended

The entry deadline for all exhibits at the Michigan State Fair has been extended from Aug. 1 to Aug. 10, it was announced by E.J. Keirns, general manager.

Keirns said his decision to extend the deadline was due to a delay in the delivery of the printed premium lists to the State Fair. These now are being mailed to former exhibitors.

Others desiring to be placed on the mailing list may write the Michigan State Fair, Detroit, 48203. Since there are three sections of the premium book — agriculture and live-stock, horse show, and community arts — requests should indicate which sections are desired, Keirns said.

An all-time high \$15,000 in premiums is being offered at this year's State Fair which will be held in Detroit from Aug. 28 through Sept. 7.
