Buy Shade During Festival

The Farmington Township Beautification Committee will be selling 500 tiny pine seedlings as part of its Founders Festival activities. The committee, which will

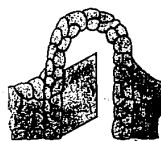
have a booth at Demery's Shopping Center, will be selling the seedlings for prices starting at 50 cents. The trees will be three to 10 inches tall. Orders also will be taken for

shade trees from Steinkopf Nursery.

For trees planted and guaranteed by the nursery, the prices are \$21 for Norway maple, red maple and

maple, and \$25 for pin oak and moraine locust.

For trees planted by the owners, the price is \$12 for the maples and \$13 for the others.



At the Center

Opperthaus Libel Suit Dismissed

The libel suit brought last year against Farmington Municipal Judge Michael Hand, Observer Newspaper's Inc., and others by Earl Opperthaus, Farmington Township trustee, was dismissed by a summary judgment by Judge Robert L. Templin last week. This suit stemmed from allegedly libelous advertising placed in The Farmington Enterprise & Observer by supporters of Hand, during his campaign for judge against Opperthaus.

Other defendants in the case were: Suzanne Shaughnessy, at that time Editor of The Enterprise & Observer; Dr. John Richardson, Farmington City Councilman; Walter McCoy; Dennis Phene; Patrick Nowak, president of the Michigan Jaycees; and William Mitchell.

All defendants refused comment on Templin's decision, pending any appeal action by Opperthaus.

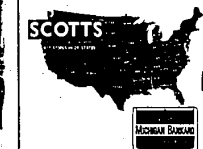
