From there he went to Bucks County,

Pa., as executive director of parks and recreation. Cakland County hired him in 1972 to manage its expanding parks

system.
Under Reickel's management, Cak-land's system grew from six parks on 2,200 acres to nine parks with 3,700

acres.

Relickel left his marks by improving facilities, organizing activities, promoting public use of the parks and raising fee revenues to supplement tax funds.


