

## Fireworks set for WB festival

This year's Greater West Bloomfield Fall Festival, to be held Sept. 7-9, will feature two nights of colorful fireworks.

The display both Friday and Saturday nights will be sponsored by West Bloomfield Hospital, a joint venture of Henry Ford and Sinai Hospitals.

For the fourth consecutive year, the festival is being held on the site of Henry Ford Hospital West Bloomfield Center, 6777 Maple Road, which is also the site of the proposed West Bloomfield Hospital.

The fireworks displays will begin at approximately 9:15 p.m. each evening and last for about 25 minutes. Each night's display will include more than 100 "shells" of varying sizes and colors, with a 140-rocket grand finale.

Joe LaVerdi of Orchard Lake will serve as the pyrotechnician for the displays. He has staged fireworks displays for the Upper Struts Festival, the Orchard Lake Country Club's July 4 exhibit, and for the Traverse City Cherry Festival.

Also for the first time, the festival will include a "Las Vegas-style casino" to be held in the HFH West Bloomfield Center lobby and sponsored by the Center's Employee Activities Committee.

It will feature games of chance with proceeds going to purchase a "Resuscitator" for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) classes. Festival-goers must be 18 or older to play.

Other festival activities will include a carnival, arts and crafts show, hot air balloons, music, a dunk tank, information booths and refreshments.

Hours are 6-10 p.m. Friday, Sept. 6; noon to 10 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 8, and 1-7 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 9. Parking service on the grounds will be provided by the West Bloomfield Optimists at \$1 per car.

Morton Plotnick, executive director of the Jewish Community Center, is president of the festival committee; Linda Messina, administrative manager of the HFH West Bloomfield Center, is vice president.
