DNR opens office in Plymouth Center

The Michigan Department of Natural Resources is opening a new environmental protection office in the vacant Plymouth Center for Human Development this week.

Slated as part of a major reorganization effort, the new office will bouse 30 to 40 staff members. It will serve five counties — Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Monroe and St. Clair.

DNR officials say the Impetus came from DNR Director Ronald Skoog, who has given top priority to environmental protection since coming to Michigan a year ago from Alaska.

"The move will improve communi-cations between the divisions, which of-ten work on the same cases," said Bill Marks of the EFB office in Landing.

Nine such consolidations are planned throughout the state, officials said, be-cause of increased workloads generat-ted by new environmental legislation and public awareness.






