## Clarenceville contract settled

The Clarenceville School District has come to contract terms with nine administrators and 25 non-certified person-nel for the 1984-85 school year, leaving only 15 secretaries

The administrators' raises were from 5 percent to 7.73 percent, according to Ed Salisz, assistant superintendent of business, while the non-certified employees received raises of five percent.

The administrators received raises based on a complex formula that considers education level, seniority, experience and the number of students supervised.

Salisz said be expects to come to terms with the secretar-ies when talks resume after the summer receas. "We haven't had an opportunity because they've been on summer vaca-tion," he said. "We've never had a problem. They've always been congenial."

The raises were approved last week at the board of educa-tion's regular meeting. They were retroactive to July 1. The board last month voted to offer the district's 102 teachers 5-percent pay hikes for the coming year. The union will vote on the offer later this month.


