Student heads for Cambridge

"Being in the city and living right among the poverty enabled me to see the problems encountered in the city firsthand," he said.

This also spurred his interest in examining urban problems and urban affairs.

At Cambridge, Sugrue will attend Kings College, one of about 30 divisions of the university, and, Sugrue added, the most informal.

Formality is still a big part of the English culture, especially at Cambridge, said Sugrue.

"Each college is autonomous from the other, and some are extremely formal, requiring that you wear tuxedos or your academic robes to dinner," Sugrue said.

"There won't be any soup kitchens at Cambridge," he said with a laugh, "but I expect to be active in religious and political organizations."

Sugrue said the academic experience will be "very challenging" because he will work under one professor for one term. There are three terms in a year.

"It's a one-on-one situation — just you and the professor discussing the material. You don't have the anonymity of a big lecture hall," he added.

After two years of study, Sugrue will take a series of comprehensive exams,

covering the six or seven areas he studied during that time.

"It's going to be really intense," Sugrue admitted.

"I'll have to retain everything I've read and talked about for two years."

AFTER CAMBRIDGE, Sugrue plans to continue his study of history at the graduate level. Then he'd like to teach the subject at a university.

"I'd like to bring back from Britain the tools to do a comparative study between British and American history," Sugrue said.

"I want to make my history studies applicable to today," he explained. To really understand the problems of today we must, Sugrue said, go back to the past.

"Through looking at past failures and looking for examples of successes we can emulate or get inspiration for today," he said.
