Readers respond to cable rate increase request

This week, Oral Quarrel asked read-ers: How do you feel about MetroVi-sion's proposed rate increase? Following are the responses:

\$7.25 to \$9.95 is ridiculous. Perhaps more nominal increase would be ap-ropriate.

Definitely no increase. The first thing they can do when they raise them is come and take the cable out of my house.

I think it is ridiculous to raise the raies to \$9.95. We get very little for the \$7.25 we have now. Every time there is a rain storm the cable goes out. No, I don't think they should raise the rates.

I don't think that Metrovision should be allowed to raise their rates. We get poor service now as it is living in Farmington. The other communities around here do not pay as much as we do for cable.

I would discontinue my cable service.

I feel MetroVision is an extremely inferior service. I am surprised that Farmington signed up for it. Our recep-tion is very poor and much better when we disconnect it and use our antenna. we disconnect it and use our antenna. And to put the leing on the cake, with the system down today, the phone numbers have all been disconnected and the ones that haven't have been changed to a unpublished number so there is powhere to even complain. We are not getting our money's worth let alone have to pay more for this inferior service.

I don't think their reasons for an in-crease in rates are justified. They gave a very vague reason to offset addi-

tional costs on building the cable sys-tem in the tri-city area. That to me is too vague. I don't believe that is justi-lied at all. I see no reason for an in-crease. I think it is just an excuse to rip off the people.

told I was going to charged an installa-tion fee when the city had agreed that there wouldn't be an installation fee in-itially. Now they are asking for a rate increase for an non-existance service. Forget it.

I think it is a ripoff. At least 25 per-cent of the time one of the channels does not come in, and there is some-thing wrong with it.

MetroVision had better improve their services before they ask for more money. The list of the services on 23 is a joke. Eleven of those have nothing on them—stations 6, 10, 13, 15, 16, 16, 21, 29, 30, 31 and 44. Furthermore as nouncements on 3 are hard to read, run together and often misspelled. Don't they ever proofered? Information on the weather channels specifically monthly rainfall often gets lost and never replaced. It takes several days to correct faulty stations. Quite frankly we have been disappointed with Metro-Vision. We expected more after seeing the cable systems and their services in other communities.
