FITNESS — Enjoy toning your body to a formulated routine of exercises and dance. HUNTER'S SAFETY CLINIC — In accordance with Michigan State law, participation in a certified Hunter's Safety Clinic is required for all youth 12-16 years of age wishing to purchase their first hunting license. This six-hour course is designed to teach the individual all aspects of hunter's safety and, after successful completion of the course, the individual will receive a Hunter's Safety Certificate. Class will be held Wednesday, Sept. 19 and Tuesday, Sept. 25, 6-9 p.m. at the Farmington Hills Library, 32737 12 Mile. A preregistration fee of \$1 is required and may be submitted to the Parks & Recreation office.

WESTERN HORSEBACK RIDING LESSONS — Enjoy learning the basic skills of western horseback riding at Windshire Equestrian Academy, 2552 Wixom Road, in Milford. Classes are designed for beginner, 8 years old and above, who have never had previous riding lessons, and advanced beginner, 8 years old and above, who have had previous riding lessons. Classes meet once a week for eight weeks at a variety of dates and times and begin the week of Sept. 24. Registrations for this

class should be made at the Parks & Recreation Office.

ADAPTIVE RECREATION — Once again a variety of recreation activities are provided to area residents who are mildly to moderately, mentally and/or physically impaired. A Coffee House drop-in center where teens and young adults can socialize and dance is held every first and third Friday starting Sept. 21. The Coffee House is at Oakland Community College, Orchard Ridge Campus, Building II and the doors open at 7 p.m. A Bowling League is also offered on Fridays at Ark West Lanes, starting at 4 p.m. The league will begin Sept. 21 and run for 12 weeks. 
