

... THE SURGERY itself is done un-der general anesthesia and has a com-plication rate of less than 1 percent, Hai said. Fatients are able to make, use of the prosthesis four to six weeks after the operation.

Hai said he performs both the semi-rigid and inflatable prosthesis sur-gery. Some men prefer the semi-rigid prosthesis because its aimpler for them to operate, with no hydraulies, and involves less surgery.
