Jewish holiday season begins

Services featuring penitential or Selichot prayers will taker in the Jewish High Holy Days on Saturday evening. Traditionally held on the Saturday evening proceeding Rosh Hashanah (Jewish New Year) they signal the approach of the most sacred days in the Jewish faith. Congregations gather in the synapogues following the conclusion of the Sabbath, sweets are eaten and a midnight service announces the approach of the new year.

Rosh Hashanh or "the head of the year' begins the 10 days of penitance which culminate at the end of Yom Kippur, the day of Atonement. This year Rosh Hashanah begins at aundown on Wednesday, Sept. 28. In Southfield's Conservative synapogues, Shaarey Zedek, Brai David and Beth Achlm, it will be observed for two days.

Yom Kippur will begin at sundown, Friday, Oct. 5, and is observed by fasting and prayer for 24 hours.
During the 10 days of Penltence, Jewish people believe that mankind passes in judgement before God. They deeply reflect, pondering their deeds and spiritual behavior over the preceding 12 months.

ON YOM Kippur, families gather-for a festive meal, light candles, and and forgiveness of me another formit and forgiveness of me another formit of the property of the second of the property of the second of the second against one another. This is the prelude to 24 hours of prayer and fasting. Prayers are recited asking God to re-lease persons from yours undertaken but not fulfilled.
