## Cadillac Kidz band plays area

The Cadillac Kidz rocked the campus recently at Schoolcraft College in Livonia. The band was given a warm welcome by Livonians, along with many other Detroit-area people.

Band members are Mike (Spaz) Seville of Westland, lead singer; Dan Cadillac of Farmington Hills, guitar; Christopher Blaise of Detroit, bass guitar, and Ron Chambers of Royal Oak, drums.

The concert was widely publicized by radio station WLLZ-FM. The Cadillac Kidz were promoted by WLLZ as the warm-up group for Fastway, a group from England, which also sang to an estimated 2,500 screaming, cheering fans.

The Cadillac Kidz performed last week at the Michigan State Fairgrounds in Detroit, along with five other bands.

THE BAND currently is heard on a single "Shoulder to Shoulder" and is soon releasing another single called "Asymmetric." The album "WLLZ Motor City Rocks Volume II" also features the Cadillac Kidz.

Seville and Cadillac spearheaded the group. Seville has been in groups before but was high-strung and too much of a perfectionist. He was seeking a group where the chemistry was correct for him.

His friend, Cadillac, was writing all original music and had never been in a band before. Seville wanted to be in a band doing all original music. Seville knew Cadillac from another band, while Chambers was working with Blaise's brother-in-law. Thus, the birth of the Cadillac Kidz.

All four original members write music. They are an eclectic group of writers and musicians who write all their own music harmoniously. Devout and conscientious to their craft, they spent two of the six years they have been together developing and writing their music.

The members constitute a rock 'n' roll band influenced by James Brown, from soul to popular music. The band's goal, said Cadillac, is "to play for all the people of Detroit and record our music for posterity, and to make a living playing music — which is the thing we love to do."

EACH member is multi-talented. In addition to their regular instruments, Blaise plays keyboard, guitar and banjo. Seville and Chambers play the guitar.
