

Patio doors — link to outdoors

Warm weather and outdoor cooking go together. So do kitchens and patios. What often brings them together, because of their easy access, are patio doors — when they work the way they should.

When they don't, they should be replaced. Andersen Corp. of Bayport, Minn., has a gliding patio door which is especially sized to fit into the rough opening left by most six-foot metal sliding doors.

In most cases, the Perma-Shield replacement unit can be installed without major remodeling, reframing or residing.

Following a set of instructions from Andersen, the new gliding patio door can be installed by a do-it-yourselfer in a day, though some help may be needed to lift the unit into position.

COMBINING energy conservation, low maintenance, good looks and safety, the special-sized gliding patio door has double-pane safety insulating glass as standard.

The glazing is designed to withstand impact. If it does break under severe impact, the glass crumbles into small

pieces that reduce the chance of serious injury.

Available as an option is Andersen's new high-performance insulating glass which is even better at saving energy than triple glazing.

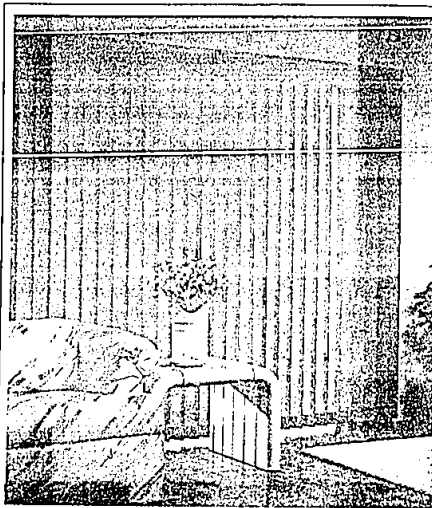
It consists of a micro-thin coating that is permanently bonded to the air-space surface of the inside pane so there is nothing to clean, install or operate, nor will the coating crack, wrinkle or roll up.

In summer, much of the radiant heat from outdoors is blocked by the high-performance insulating glass, thus reducing the load on the air conditioner.

NO MATTER what the weather, the Perma-Shield gliding patio door is designed to resist 50-mile-an-hour winds and the equivalent rainfall of eight inches per hour without leaking.

That's because of its snug fit, low-maintenance vinyl sheathing and factory-applied weatherstripping that is twice as weather-tight as industry standards for allowable air infiltration.

Many do-it-yourselfers can install flush doors

A lot of odd jobs that used to go to local handymen are winding up in the hands of homeowners themselves.

Take the replacement or installation of interior doors, for instance.

It's a fairly simple job to install an interior flush door and customize it at the same time, says the Wood Moulding and Millwork Producers Association.

Begin with the purchase of one or more pre-hung doors at local building supply stores or home centers.

Buy a few lengths of wood moulding at the same time and you'll be able to give the door a new personality.

Next, set the pre-hung door into the rough opening. Check the floor to see that it is level. If not, shim or trim one side of the jamb to make it level.

Check the clearance between the door and its frame. There should be about an eighth of an inch clearance all the way round.

If not, place shims between the jamb and the stud to assure uniform

clearance. Use 2 1/2-inch finishing nails to nail through the jamb and shim into the stud.

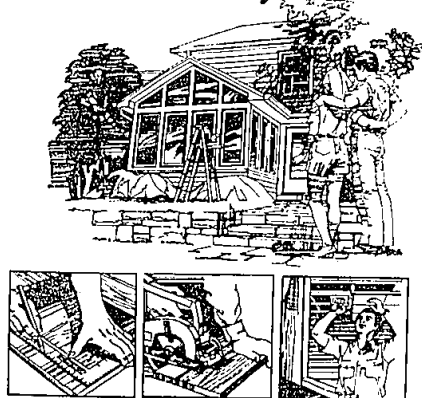
Remove the door from its hinges and lay the door flat. When all the pieces of moulding are cut, position them in the design of your choice.

Then, glue and tack them to one or both sides of the door before replacing the door in its frame and retensioning the hinges.

Open and close the door to be sure it fits properly and apply casing around the door frame to give it a finished look. Finally, paint or stain the moulding and the door in the finish of your choice.

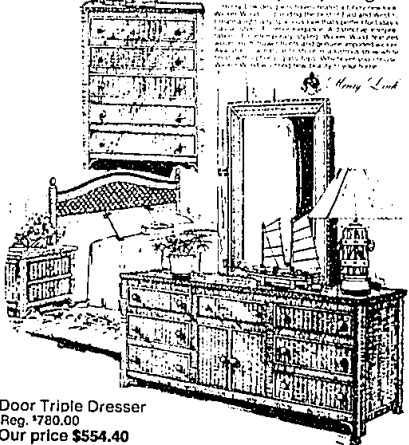

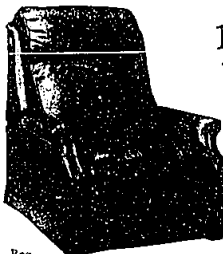
