

Andre Previn Is Guest Conductor At Festival

The Meadow Brook Music Festival moves into the sixth week of the season, with Andre Previn, pianist Jeanne Marie Darre, Al Hirt, guest conductor Everett Lee and a world premiere composed and played by Detroit's Yusef Lateef, beginning Thursday, July 30 at 8:30 p.m., on the grounds of Oakland University, Rochester.

Miss Darre, the great French piano virtuoso, will appear on Thursday and Saturday evenings at Oakland University's Baldwin Pavilion with the Detroit Symphony under the baton of Andre Previn. In the spring of 1968, Mr. Previn was appointed chief conductor of the London Symphony Orchestra and, for the past decade, he has been one of the most sought-after guest conductors of the world's major symphony orchestras.

Moviegoers would remember some of his most famous film scores.

On Friday at 8:30 p.m. Meadow Brook will welcome America's greatest trumpet showman, Al Hirt, with his sidekicks Pee Wee and The Young Set. Today Mr. Hirt is "The King," the most famous trumpet player the entertainment world has ever known. This fact is reflected in the largest advance ticket sale of the Meadow Brook season.

On Sunday at 6:30 p.m., guest conductor Everett Lee will lead the Detroit Symphony in a "Pops" program which will feature the Yusef Lateef Quartet and the world premiere of Mr. Lateef's "Symphonic Blues Suite for Quartet and Orchestra."

DETROIT'S YUSEF LATEEF is considered one of the most skilled flutists active today. He has also mastered tenor and alto saxophones, oboe, bassoon, bamboo flute (his own invention) and such exotic instruments as the shan-

Chorale, Strings Are Featured

The third and final court orchestra concert in Schoolcraft College's Summer Music Festival will feature the Kenneth Jewell Chorale and several solo string quartets in what promises to be an interesting program. Curtain time is 8:30 tonight (Wednesday, July 29) in the Waterman Student Center.

It will open with a "Fantasia on a Theme of Thomas Tallis," written in 1910 by Vaughan Williams, in which a string quartet will be backed by two string orchestras. Tallis was a 16th Century composer of church music.

THE CHORALE WILL appear in "Cantata Miserere," Opus 88, by Benjamin Britten, a dramatic work written for the 100th anniversary of the International Red Cross, and first performed in Geneva, Switzerland, in 1963. It features a Latin text by the Modern English composer, in a retelling of the parable of the Good Samaritan. Solo voices will pose the question "Who is thy neighbor?" and the Chorale will answer, along with a solo string quartet, and the orchestra, in which the strings, piano, harp and timpani will play prominent roles.

A rarely-heard work by Vaughan Williams, "Flos Campi," will open the second half of the program. In this the Chorale is used instrumentally. There is no text, although the work is based on six passages from the Song of Solomon.

David Ireland will play the viola solo. According to Allen Shaffer who is on the Music School faculty, this is a remarkable work, and Schoolcraft is fortunate in having just the right ingredients for its presentation, a chorus, a violin and a small orchestra. Although taken from the Bible, it is described as being romantic and pastoral in quality.
