

Actress wins role in play

Kathy Ann Klein of Farmington has been cast at Eastern Michigan University in the season opener, "Blood Wedding." Managing Director of the Quirk Theatre, Kenneth Stevens, says that "Blood Wedding" "blends cultural traditions of Japan's Kabuki Theatre and the poetic romanticism of classic Spanish Theatre."

In this tragedy of passion, playwright Garcia Lorca tells of the mother that has lost all but her youngest son in blood feuds. Immediately following the son's wedding, the bride runs off with another, only to end as a witness to a double killing.

Klein, daughter of Arnold and Sally Klein of Farmington Hills, previously appeared in "Street Scene" as Mrs. Florentino; as Mr. Toad in "Wind in the Willows"; and as Hecuba in "The Trojan Women." In Blood Wedding she characterizes the Beggar Woman.

Klein is a Junior, majoring in theater at Eastern Michigan University. "Blood Wedding" opens Oct. 16 and plays Tuesday through Saturday at 8


Upon graduation in December from Madonna with a degree in music education, Newby will enter the University
