However, this Sunday's participants were eventually identified. They ranged in age from eight to 13 years of age. They had wandered nearly a mile from each of their respective homes, in the pouring rain, before they came upon and proceeded to damage our property.

After contacting the homes of each of these four children, I discovered that poverty and a difference of race were not factors here. What I did realize is that effective parental control and discipline, respect for authority and respect for the property of others were the most important factors involved in Livonia or anywhere else.
