NECK STRAIN

Most neck pains are the result of muscle strain. Because these muscles must hold up and turn the head, the neck area has developed a complex array of interweaving muscle fibers. Any of these muscle groups can develop a strain, which you feel as a neck ache. Since the cause of such pain is from strain, not inflammation, blood tests are of little value in determining the reason for neck discomfort. X-rays can be deceptive. Findings in the neck vertebrae such as extra bone and loss of disc spaces, often are called "Arthritis". However these changes may be found in people of similar age, background, and occupation who have no neck complaints. Initial therapy for neck pain consists of heat, traction and proper posture. Posture is of particular importance as a correct relationship between head and neck puts the least strain on neck muscles. These measures are not dramatic, but persistence in their use generally brings relief.
