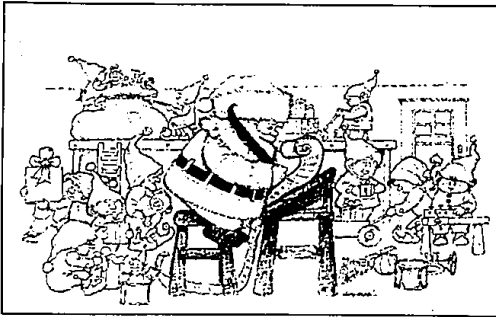


# Cards perpetuate season's generosity

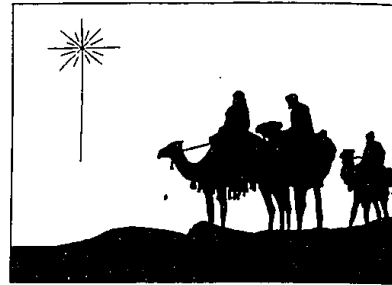

## Arthritis Foundation

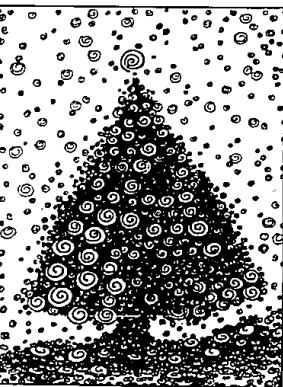

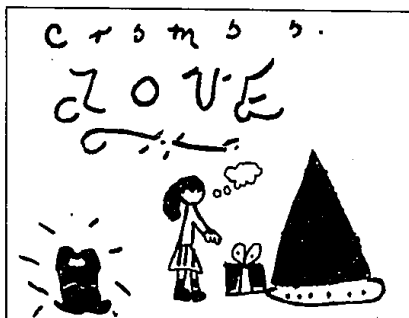

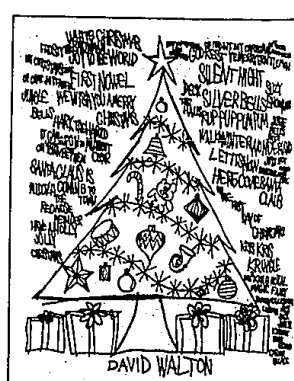
## Methodist Children's Home Society

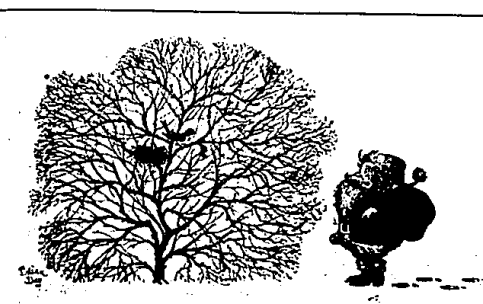
## Children's Hospital of Michigan
