Parking program aids yule shoppers

Parking places expand by 5,000 at Twelve Oaks as employees park off-site during the 20 peak holiday shopping days.
"We want to do everything possible to provide shopping convenience for our shoppers," says William Clogg, manager of Twelve Oaks.

"We've arranged to park over 1,000 employee cars at the Novi Hilton Inn throughout the busy holiday season," Clogg says.

"Assuming that shoppers rotate the same parking space at least five times during center hours, we will be parking an additional 5,000 cars daily this holiday season."

Responding to the heavy demand in parking spaces during this major selling season, Twelve Oaks has coordinated a major off-site parking program for store employees.

The Novi Hilton is scheduled to open in early '85.

The parking lot had been paved in preparation for the opening and provided a ready-made location to accommodate the employees' cars.

Joe Gerak, the developer of the project and Gary Seibert, the Novi Hilton general manager, said, "We are very pleased to work with Twelve Oaks on this project. It's an excellent example of good neighbors in the business community, working together."
