males are the subjects appear to visualize contemporary fables with messages that are both startling and frightening. These works command attention like a drill sergeant and there is no denying their presence.

ON THE OPPOSITE wall is an installation by Tom Marioni of San Francisco. In front of his large facsimile of Picasso's painting, "Guernica," is an observation platform (part of the art, but also functional) which provides an interesting perspective of the painting behind it as well as the art nearby.

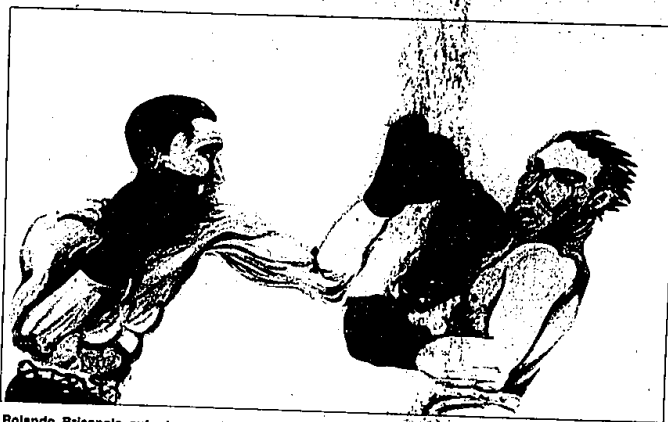
Among the other works in the show that are of a more intimate scale is a selection of variations on the chair by Margaret Wharton of Glenview, Ill. One of the most compelling of these is a wood and epoxy piece titled, "Mocking Bird."

This show, like many of late, signals the resurgence of interest in imagery. But here, particularly, it is recognizable images coupled with a bite, a stretch, a blending of past and future thought in both technique and comment that gives the strong impact.

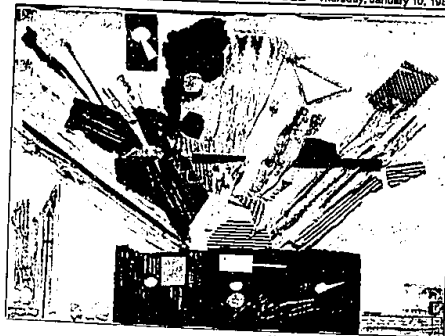
This is the final stop for the exhibition which will be at Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum through Sunday, Jan. 20.
