CROSS COUNTRY SKI LESSONS — The Parks and Recreation Division will be offering cross country ski lessons at Glen Oaks Ski Center. Lessons will be available on the weekends for beginner and intermediate skiers at 10 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. All lessons are 1½ hours long. The fee for the lessons will be \$11, including ski rental; \$6 with your own equipment. Ski lessons are pre-registration only at the Parks and Recreation office.

AFTER SCHOOL REGISTRATION — The activity flyers will soon be distributed through the Farmington School area schools and registration for the winter season of the after school recreation will soon begin. Classes will include gymnastics, rhythmic gymnastics, ballet, kid's kitchen, woodworking and more.
