Michigan's chefs

A prediction that Michigan "is becoming a strong force in the world of fine foods" is made by Reed Ashton, owner of the Golden Mushroom in Southfield. Ashton, who is on the board of the Michigan Restaurant Association, pointed to Michigan's food service education programs and the recent showing of Michigan chefs in the 16th International Culinary Olympics. Four Michigan chefs were among 50 American chefs at the Olympics. Miles Chelka, master chef at the Golden Mushroom, and Jeff Gabriel, executive chef at the Grosse Pointe Yacht Club, each were awarded a gold medal with distinction, for "perfect" entries. Dan Hugellier, executive chef of Schuler's, was on the U.S. National Team. He also won a gold cloverleaf award for his centerpiece of shaped dough. Kamel Kaspi, chef of Detroit's Renaissance Club, earned gold and bronze medals.

Madeline Triffon, sommelier at Detroit's Westin Hotel since it first opened in 1977, was selected as the fourth best sommelier in the nation in the recent French Wine Sommelier Contest in America. Food and Wine from France SOPEX, a French government agency, conducted the contest. Triffon was the only woman among the 12 finalists, who vied at the Waldorf-Astoria in New York.

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
