

Falcons tumble past Seaholm for 1st win

You know it was only a matter of time for the Farmington gymnastics team.

After losing its first four meets, two by narrow margins, Farmington broke through Thursday night with a 104.1-105.5 victory against Birmingham Seaholm.

Katie MacIntosh was solid as usual for the Falcons winning the uneven parallel bars with an 8.2, placing second on balance beam (7.8) and third on vault (7.05).

But the Falcons were boosted by the improvement of Debi DeWitt and Stacy Swaderaki.

DeWitt won the floor exercise with an 8.35. She took fourth on bars (5.2) and fifth on beam (6.75).
