# Plea made for capital punishment

Children as young as 14-years-old abould be, in certain cases, prosecuted as adults, according to Oakland County Prosecutor L. Brooks Patterson.

That's what Patterson told students at Farmington High School during a re-

cent visit.

"I feel that they ought to reduce the jage of the juvenile from its present level down to 14, in recognition of the lact that there is much more violent jarline committed by juveniles," Patterson told the students.

At present, couris consider 17 as the demarcation line for adulthood. Juven-lies who are 15 and 16 can be tried as an adult in circuit court with the permission of the courts, according to Patterson.

Patterson noted that other states have lowered the discretionary age to

form of punishment, like time in juve-nite home, or community service, as re-tribution," he said.

Patterson was speaking at Farming-ton High while stumping for relastate-ment of capital punishment in Michi-gan, a goat he has been seeking for a number of years.

He urged those who are 18 to become active in the movement by circulating petitions to get the question placed on the ballot. Anyone who is 18 in 1988 will be able to vote on the capital punishment question.

"Capital punishment does deter-crime," he told the students. "If a few people are stopped because of the threat of capital punishment, then it has to be a gain."

To support his beliefs that capital punishment is a deterrent, Patterson referred to studies by Isaac Ehrlich, a professor at the University of Chicago. He attempted to show mathematically that capital punishment acts as a deterrent.
