## Liberty Love Day is proclaimed

The National Society Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) has proclaimed Thursday, Feb. 14, as "Liberty Love Day." On this day, all 211,000 members will participate in a one-day nationally coordinated effort to raise funds for the restoration of the Statue of Liberty.

Locally, the Quakertown Chapter of Farmington is sponsoring the effort, with each member making her own

contribution and contacting at least five non-members for donations.

The Statue of Liberty will be 100 years old in 1986, and a major undertaking is in progress to restore it. The ravages of time, salt air and pollution have taken a serious toll. Work is being done on the skeletal structure as well as the outside to insure the preservation of the symbol of freedom.

It will take over two years to complete the restoration and cost a total of \$45 million, according to the Statue of Liberty-Ellis Island Foundation. The rededication is scheduled for the statue's birthday, Oct. 28, 1986.

Both the statue, built in France, and its pedestal, built in the U.S. were funded by private citizens. The restoration is being paid for in the same way.

The DAR has chosen Valentine's Day as an appropriate time for an outpouring of love and support for Lady Liberty with over 200,000 daughters united to help another damsel in distress.
