Reye syndrome is a rare Heye syndrome is a rare but dangerous condition that can develop from flu or chicken pox. It occurs mainly in children under 16, usually when they ap-pear to be recovering. Watch for these signs:

Persistent vomiting
Fatigue
Confusion and belligerence.

If your child displays any of these symptoms, con-sult a doctor immedi-ately.

Some studies indicate that there may be an as-sociation between the use of aspirin for flu and chicken pox and the de-velopment of Reye syn-drome. Further studies are being conducted on this possibility. In the meantime, the U.S. Sur-geon General suggests that you check with your doctor before using aspi-rin or any medication when your child has flu or chicken pox.
