Faxon addresses Democratic Club

State Sen. Jack Faxon, D-Farmington Hills, will be the principal speaker at the regular monthly meeting of the Farmington Democratic Club at 8 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 28 in Botsford Inn, Grand River at Eight Mile.

Faxon will speak on recent develop-

ments in the Michigan Legislature where he serves as a member of the Senate Appropriations Committee. The meeting is open to the public. There will also be a report on the recent state Democratic Party convention.

Registration set for kindergarten

Kindergarten registration for the 1985-86 school year will be held at the Farmington elementary schools the week of March 4 during regular school hours.

Parents need to complete registration forms and present the child's birth

certificate at the local elementary school office. Parents will receive information regarding preschool testing and kindergarten orientation program. The child must be 5 years of age on or before Dec. 1, 1985 to be eligible for kindergarten attendance.

Wayne offers scholarship

Three faculty fellowships, each providing \$8,000 a year for two years to an eminent senior scholar at Wayne State University, will be created with proceeds from a charitable trust established by the late Charles Gershenson, a prominent Detroit businessman and philanthropist.

Creation of the Gershenson Faculty Fellowships was announced by WSU President David Adamany at the Board of Governors meeting Feb. 15. Fellows will be permitted to use the \$8,000 for any purpose to support the

the president said.

"The Gershenson Fellowships," Adamany said, "represent a pattern we're trying to establish of external support for scholarship by the faculty. We are exploring other opportunities for funding of similar programs to support faculty research and scholarship."

Appointed to WSU's Board of Governors by former Michigan governor George Romney in the early 1980s, Gershenson also served for many years on the Board of Advisors of the Univer-

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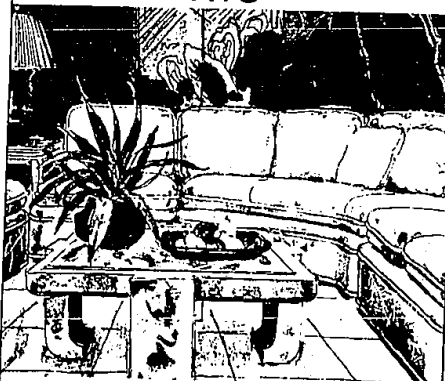
